ORDER

[1] On application by Dale Brown, solicitor for Saskatchewan Government Insurance (“SGI”), for an adjournment of the hearing on the basis that additional time is required to review and assess new medical evidence presented at the hearing, by the Appellant, R.L., the hearing is adjourned under the following circumstances:

- (1) SGI shall provide the new medical opinions to their medical consultants for review and assessment and, if necessary, obtain updated medical assessments and measurements. Upon receipt of any new medical reports and medical assessments, SGI shall provide a copy to the Appellant for her review.
- (2) SGI shall provide the Appellant with a written decision regarding their assessment of the Appellant’s entitlement to additional permanent impairment benefits.
- (3) The appeal hearing is adjourned to January 10, 2006.
- (4) If the Appellant and SGI can not, on the basis of the new medical assessments, come to an agreement regarding the Appellant’s entitlement to additional permanent impairment benefits, the appeal hearing shall resume on January 10, 2006.
- (5) If the Appellant and SGI come to an agreement regarding the Appellant’s entitlement to additional benefits, the applicant shall withdraw her appeal to the Appeal Commission.
