CONSENT ORDER

WITH THE CONSENT OF THE PARTIES, the within appeal, filed March 2, 2005, shall be disposed of as follows:

1. The June 16, 2004 decision of the Respondent, Saskatchewan Government Insurance, determining the Appellant into the position of a Materials Handler is set aside;
2. The Respondent is directed to make a determination in accordance with Section 134 of *The Automobile Accident Insurance Act*;
3. The claimant's appeal of the Respondent's assessment of Permanent Impairment Benefits is allowed in respect of the claimant's scarring and accordingly, Permanent Impairment Benefits shall be increased by \$692.86 and the Appellant acknowledges receipt of this amount.
4. The Appellant is entitled to his costs as prescribed by subsection 193(11) of *The Automobile Accident Insurance Act* and Regulation 96(1), in the amount of \$2,500.00;
5. The Appellant shall be reimbursed for his expenses in obtaining reports pursuant to section 169 of *The Automobile Accident Insurance Act* and Regulation 76 in the aggregate amount of \$80.00; and

6. The Appellant shall be refunded his appeal fee in accordance with regulation 86(4).


