## ORDER

[1] The Appellant appealed a decision by Saskatchewan Government Insurance (SGI) and has applied for the exclusion of certain documents filed by SGI respecting that appeal. It is his position that the documents were provided to SGI in error and further, that he did not authorize their release to SGI. The Commission was empanelled on this date to hear and determine this preliminary matter only without consideration of the merits of the appeal.

[2] After hearing the parties, the Panel provided its decision orally as follows:

- A. The Commission will not decide now or at any time whether the Appellant's privacy rights have been breached by SGI or whether SGI acquired the disputed information improperly. Those questions properly lie in another forum.
- B. We have been advised that the Privacy Commissioner is presently considering at least some of the matters raised in this application and that his work is ongoing. We do not have sufficient information to determine whether or how that process might affect the positions taken by the parties or the Commission. Given that, the matter will be adjourned.
- C. In the interim, the Appellant will obtain from the Privacy Commissioner a letter of report setting out what issues are under consideration, what is being done, what stage the work is at and the anticipated time frame until it is completed. That letter of report will be filed with the Commission prior to the adjourned date.
- D. In the interim, SGI will prepare and provide a letter of report setting out, to the extent of its knowledge and understanding, the issues under the Privacy Commissioner's consideration, what is being done, what stage the work is at and the anticipated time frame until it will be completed. SGI's letter of report will be filed with the Commission prior to the adjourned date.

[3] The matter is adjourned to 3:00 p.m. on July 16, 2008. The parties will appear by telephone on that date unless either of them advises before that date that he prefers to appear in person.
